CRAFTON WINS POLE AT TEXAS! (November 6, 2009)

Matt Crafton captured his second NCWTS Keystone Light Pole Award of the season at Texas Motor Speedway on Thursday. It is Crafton's first at TMS in eighteen career starts. He also won the Pole Award at Chicagoland in August.

Said Crafton, driver of the No. 88 Menards/McGuire-Nicholas Chevy Silverado:
